The Solution

The PVC-u Anti-bacterial Impact Protection Sheet from Intastop has myriad benefits for building maintenance and as part of an infection control programme due to the incorporation of Hygienilac®.

Providing an impact resistant surface the sheet is Class 'O' Fire Rated and tested to BS476 Parts 6 & 7 meeting building safety and infrastructure requirements. It is easily cut to size on site using a Stanley knife or they can be manufactured to individual specifications, pre-cut to size for half-height and shaped plates, or edges chamfered to order. Standard sheet thickness is 2mm although other thicknesses are available on request.

On this occasion Intastop were commissioned to fit the panels, and used JMB Installations, to ensure the project was completed overnight whilst the theatres were closed.

"We have used products by Intastop for several years throughout our Fairfield site for wall and door protection behind our bed heads and on doors. On this latest occasion, we chose the door protection sheets to upgrade our theatre doors which had been damaged and were in need of refurbishing.

Our preference is to choose the anti-bacterial textured sheet as it offers added benefits in our setting over the smooth version hiding any scuff marks that occur from trolleys, and, whilst there is a fantastic colour range to choose from we selected grey once again so that the colour scheme flowed throughout the hospital and allowed us to have spare sheet that could be used in any setting for on going repairs and maintenance.

The Intastop team worked well and completed the work to a very high standard within the agreed time scale. In addition to this particular project other Intastop projects have since been specified including the aluminium door edge protection strips, continuous hinges and co-ordinating plastic corner guards.

Since the installation of the door protection sheets we have also started using the aluminium roller bar frame protectors. An initial trial in our RESUS area in the Accident and Emergency Department proved to be hugely successful and this product has now been fitted to all door casings in our theatres."
